- Participate in administrative duties related to teaching and support the undergraduate teaching programme with lectures, practicals/tutorials, examinations.

- General paediatric and adult liver pathology, to include congenital and acquired liver diseases requiring organ transplantation.
- Assessment of donor suitability.
- Complications related to recipient organ including recognition of mechanical failure, rejection and the grading thereof, infections related to immune suppression, drug toxicity, post-transplant lymphoproliferative disorders.
- Long term assessment of recipient liver biopsies months and years from transplantation.
- Cut-up of explanted organs.
- Reporting of surgical biopsy samples and liver resections pertaining to transplant work and liver/ gastro-intestinal disease in general.
